

LITURGY CORNER



Father's Day is always celebrated on the third Sunday of June. The origins of the day aren't really clear, but it's thought that it was first celebrated about 100 years ago in a Methodist Church in Fairmont, West Virginia. While we think of this as another day of barbecues, ballgames, and perhaps a round of golf, we should think of the biblical examples set for fathers throughout our faith. First of all, honoring our fathers with a special day is in keeping with the biblical commandment to honor our fathers and mothers. Not just one day a year, but every day. Second, we can look at the biblical examples of fatherhood. We start with Abraham, who is revered as the father of faith by Jews, Christians, and Moslems. Abraham had faith in God that his children would someday become a great nation. We have the example of the father of the prodigal son who showed faith that his son would return to him. Also, Jairus who in spite of his wealth and prestige, threw himself humbly before Jesus so that his daughter could be cured. Most importantly, we have Joseph of Galilee, who perhaps is the most exemplary of fathers. He believed in God's message and took Mary as his wife and raised Jesus as his own son because he had faith that God was working through him and Mary. May we honor our fathers today and every day.

A Father's Day Prayer

God our Father, you govern and protect your people and shepherd them with a father's love. You place a father in a family as a sign of your love, care, and constant protection. May fathers everywhere be faithful to the example shown in the Scriptures: steadfast in love, forgiving transgressions, sustaining the family, caring for those in need. Give your wisdom to fathers that they may encourage and guide their children. Keep them healthy so they may support a family. Guide every father with the Spirit of your love that they may grow in holiness and draw their family ever closer to you.

From the Bell Tower...

Ring-ring-ring! If you've ever paid particular attention to the bells at St. Gabriel, you'll happen to notice that they ring before the beginning of Mass on the weekend and regularly at noon and 6:00pm. In our Catholic Tradition, bells have commonly been used for many centuries as a means to call the faithful to prayer. At the 6:00am, noon, and 6:00pm hours, the bells call us to pray The Lord's Prayer and the Angelus (a prayer honoring the Incarnation of God). You may have noticed recently that there has been the addition of the ringing of the bells at the 3:00pm hour. Why? During this year of Mercy we have been looking for new ways to avail ourselves to the bountiful mercy of God. The ringing of the bells at 3:00pm is meant to draw our attention to the time traditionally held that Christ died upon The Cross to save us from our sins. May we take some time at this sacred hour of the day for prayer and remember Christ's saving sacrifice that sets us free from our sins.

Summer Storms ...

We are well into summer and winter snow storms are a distant memory. But, summer storms can bring dangers of their own. One of the biggest dangers is lightning. On average, 50 people in the U.S. become lightning fatalities each year. Usually the cause of death when struck by lightning is cardiac arrest which stops the heart from beating. Some pretty basic suggestions can help prevent more people from becoming a statistic. If you hear thunder (even in the distance) get inside a building with wiring/plumbing or a metal topped vehicle! We see sporting events where games are delayed for thunder yet players and fans are allowed to stay by the fields! If you are stuck outside, avoid open areas, stay away from tall isolated trees, water and metal objects. Even if you are indoors avoid water, metal, electrical appliances and using landline telephones. Most of these either attract or conduct electricity both of which are dangerous. Stay indoors at least 30 minutes after the last thunder boom is heard. www.lightningsafety.noaa.gov Remember the National Weather Service motto, "When thunder roars, get indoors!" *Here's to our health!*





