

Confirmation Service Opportunities

Each year we have various parish service opportunities that our candidates can take part in.

WHAT ARE SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES?

When we share God's love through our actions or deeds to benefit others. Service opportunities allow us to show that we truly believe in Jesus and what He has taught us to do.

WHY DO WE HAVE TO?

As Christians, we are called to serve Christ and others. In Matthew 5:16 Jesus tells us **“Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father.”** This is part of our Christian mission, to love and serve our neighbors. By doing this, we glorify God.

WHY DO WE DO IT FOR CONFIRMATION?

At Baptism we enter into God's family and are called to be witnesses to the faith. At Confirmation, that baptismal call is strengthened, and we are given the power of the Holy Spirit to “go out” and be living disciples of Christ. Part of being a disciple is leading by example, serving others as Jesus did. We want to use the power of the Holy Spirit to build the Kingdom of God through loving service.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

You will receive an email with the link to sign-up. You can also sign up on the parish website, www.st-gabriel.org Scroll over to “Sacraments” and click on “Confirmation.” This will take you to our Confirmation page with the link to our service opportunities. Candidates are required to complete one service project as part of their Confirmation preparation. If you volunteered at the festival, Vacation Bible School, or are an altar server, these count as your service project. You would just need to complete the report.

SERVICE REPORT

Upon completion of the service project, a report is required (on the back side of this page). You can also find and download the report on the website.
